**Stewardship Reflection: Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*“He said, ‘Come.’ Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus.” Matthew 14:29*



When you hear Jesus calling, do you respond immediately and trust He knows what He's doing? If so, you are walking on water! When we say “yes” to Jesus, we are acting as His **Stewards** and feel the power of His presence in our lives. We can feel the freedom it gives us! Listen how Jesus is calling you

to live the extraordinary life He has in mind for you!



**The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**  
**A Holy Day of Obligation**  
**August 15, 2017**

At the end of its Constitution on the Church, the Second Vatican Council left us a very beautiful meditation on the mystery that we celebrate on the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

*“The Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all guilt of original sin, on the completion of her earthly sojourn, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen of the universe, that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and the conqueror of sin and death.” (Lumen Gentium #59)*

Then, towards the end, there is:

*“...In the interim just as the Mother of Jesus, glorified in body and soul in heaven, is the image and beginning of the Church as it is to be perfected in the world to come, so too does she shine forth on earth, until the day of the Lord shall come, as a sign of sure hope and solace to the people of God during its sojourn on earth.” (Lumen Gentium # 68)*

The Gospel reading includes the well-known words of the “Hail Mary” and the powerful phrases of Mary’s “Magnificat.” Mary truly is “blessed among women.” Her soul truly “proclaims the greatness of the Lord.”

With St. Elizabeth, may we “hail” Mary, recognizing her as the Mother of God. And with our Blessed Mother Mary, may we make our own her prayer: “My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.”

**Small Christian Community Faith Sharing**

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

**Excerpt from the Gospel for the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time, August 20, 2017 - Matt. 15:21-28**


At that time, Jesus withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a Canaanite woman of that district came and called out, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon." But Jesus did not say a word in answer to her. Jesus' disciples came and asked him, "Send her away, for she keeps calling out after us." He said in reply, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But the woman came and did Jesus homage, saying, "Lord, help me." He said in reply, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." She said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Then Jesus said to her in reply, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." And the woman's daughter was healed from that hour.

**Commentary:**

The account in this Gospel passage shows that while in the beginning the Good News was preached only to the Jews, there would come a time when all people would be included. Jesus tells his disciples here that his mission is to "the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But at the end of Matthew's Gospel, the Risen Christ will command the apostles to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations." This story is a turning point in Jesus' mission. The woman's humility and "great faith" were not to be denied. Faith in the Lord will bring both Jews and Gentiles to healing and salvation.

**Questions for Reflection and Sharing:**



1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Commentary resonates with me?
