## The Catholic Faith in Slow Motion (No. 105)

*Fr. Phillip Johnson*

*Professing, praying, and living the Faith of the Church*

### **Our Father**

*Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he ceased, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray', (literally, "give us a prayer). "And he said to them, 'When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven...'” Lk. 11: 1-2; Matt. 6: 9-13*

This particular address to God is no longer a surprise and a mystery. Millions assume that “Father” is a universal and generic way of speaking to God, an obvious synonym for “God”. So the first thing we need to know in receiving this prayer from Jesus is its specific origin in the Christian revelation. That the eternal creator condescends to be addressed by us as “*Abba, Father*” (Gal. 4:6) is anything but an obvious religious truism. As the liturgy teaches us, it is only “At the Savior’s command, and *formed by divine teaching* [that] we dare to say, Our Father.

*Whose Father...?*

The foundational relationship in the Gospels is not the one between Jesus and his followers; it is rather the relation of Jesus to the one Jesus alone addresses as “my Father” (Matt. 26:39ff; John 14: 1-7. In drawing the disciples to himself, Jesus desires to share with them his own relationship with *his* Father. At the heart of his mission is the sharing of his own “spirit of Sonship” (Gal. 4:6). Jesus desires to include us in his own love for the Father and in the Father’s love for him. When he places on our lips his *Abba, Father*, he is drawing us into the ceaseless “conversation” between the Father and the Son.

*Praying Within the Mystery of Divine Love*

“No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son reveals him.” (Matt. 11:27; see also John 1:18). Christ never leaves you to pray on your own. When you pray his prayer, he is always praying in you and with you, sharing with you his intimacy with his Father. For it is only through the Son that we can know the Father. At the same time, when you pray “Our Father” in unison with Jesus and in his Name, the Father is showing you the Son. He is revealing to you how to pray and to live as a child of the Father.

So it is that to pray in faith, *Our Father*, is to be held by Grace within the never-failing exchange of love between Jesus and his Father.

The Christian may pray many prayers. But all truly Christian prayers falls within the “frame” of the Our Father. The whole prayer life of the Church on earth and in heaven is included within this prayer of the Son, *who lives and reigns with the Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.*

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### Excerpt from the Gospel for the Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time, Nov. 5, 2017 - Matt. 23:1-12

Jesus spoke to the crowds saying, "The scribes and the Pharisees... do whatsoever they tell you, but do not follow their example. All their works are performed to be seen. They love places of honor at banquets, seats of honor in synagogues, greetings in marketplaces, and the salutation 'Rabbi'. As for you, you have but one Teacher. You have but one Father in heaven. Do not be called 'Master', you have but one master, the Christ. The greatest among you must be your servant. Whoever exalts himself will be humbled; but whoever humbles himself will be exalted.

#### Commentary:

In today's gospel Jesus comes right out and accuses the scribes and Pharisees, the religious leaders, of being false. Some Pharisees, who were supposed to be role models for the people, taught one thing but lived in another way. The disciples were not to follow the Pharisees example. Jesus makes it clear to his followers that they must honor and respect God instead of being overly concerned about their own importance and power. They were called to serve others, not be applauded by them.

#### Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Reflection resonates with me?
