This past Friday, April 20, 18 of our own were confirmed by our own Bishop Sullivan. The Candidates perhaps were a little *nervous* but also *radiant*, up to their *best, present* to the action of the *Holy Spirit*, willing to accept the challenges and *rose up to the occasion*. We all ask; “what will happen from here on? Will they continue to practice their Faith, attend Mass regularly and receive the Sacraments?” They are only 14 years old and in need of example and guidance from parents, extended family, and the Parish.



Many of us wonder if and when the trend will change to a fuller active participation in our Catholic life again by families and all who have distanced themselves from it. Some heroic steps will have to be taken to dismantle a frame of mind while constructing a new one. *The Holy Spirit is ready for the action when we are.... That will*

be the day when the sports coaches will hear: “We have no time for practice on Sunday morning because our family attends Mass.” Or, “On Sundays we are too busy for sports (etc.), because we go to Church and we tend to family activities.” Or, being good people isn’t enough for us because JESUS calls us to be HOLY. Holiness for us as Catholics can’t be achieved without the help of GRACE received through the Sacraments. Sometime we like to tell God that there are too many laws to follow and we would much rather makeup our own to fit our lifestyle and schedules. Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

Excerpt from the Gospel for Sixth Sunday of Easter, May 6, 2018 - John 15:9-17

Jesus said to his disciples: "As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I love you... It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you... This I command you: love one another."

Commentary:

God's love for us is both free and costly! It is free in that God first loved and chose us; it is costly in that being loved requires us to "love one another as Christ has loved" us and to "lay down our life" for others.

Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Reflection resonates with me?

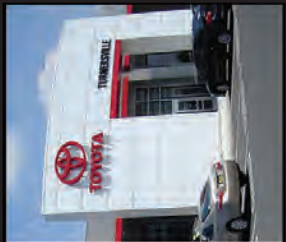
