Religious Education classes are over and will resume in September.

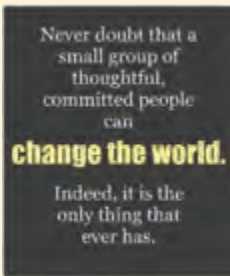
Registration forms will be **emailed** to the parents within the next week or so.

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### Excerpt from the Gospel for the Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 10, 2018 - Mark 3:20-35

....The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "By the prince of demons he drives out demons." Summoning them, he began to speak to them in parables, "How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand; that is the end of him. But no one can enter a strong man's house to plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man. Then he can plunder the house.

.... A crowd seated around him told him, "Your mother and your brothers and your sisters are outside asking for you." But he said to them in reply, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

#### Commentary:

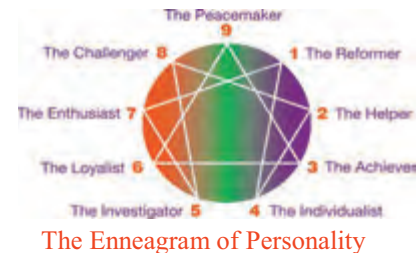
In Mark's Gospel the religious leaders mistakenly call Jesus' power satanic. His relatives think he is crazy. But we know from the from reading from Genesis that God has subdued Satan and promised redemption through his Son. This is what Jesus is getting at in his story about a household divided. Saving this house means first subduing the strong man. Jesus can overpower Satan because his power is God's. When his families arrives, he explains that accepting him and doing the will of God is more important than blood ties.

#### Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Reflection resonates with me?
