**For Our Children**

Registration forms for 2019-2020 are available on the parish's website, [stthomasmorenj.org](http://stthomasmorenj.org). Children who are being registered for first grade need to provide proof of Baptism unless baptized here at St. Thomas More.

New or transferring families need to register in the parish and at the same time the children may be registered for RE, using the appropriate form, and providing the Baptism and other sacraments certificates for the child/children as well as transfer documents from the previous parish. For more information stop by or call the RE office during the day 9-2, Monday to Thursday. Closed Friday. **The preparation for the Sacraments requires a two-year formation. Attending first grade is thus a pre-requisite before entering second grade and to prepare and receive the sacraments of First Penance and Eucharist. The same is said for the seventh grade which is followed by eighth grade and Confirmation.**

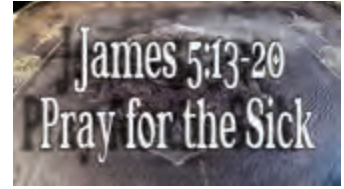

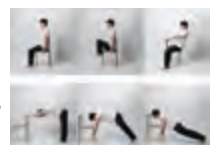

## FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, JULY 14, 2019

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### **Excerpt from the Gospel for the Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 21, 2019- Luke 10:38-42**

"Jesus entered a village where a woman whose name was Martha welcomed him. She had a sister named Mary who sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak. Martha, burdened with much serving, came to him and said, 'Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me.' The Lord said to her in reply, 'Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her.'"

#### **Commentary:**

Many of us look at Martha's behavior as "normal and worldly," while Mary's as "special and spiritual." However, there was nothing "normal" about Martha! First of all, she welcomed Jesus into her home; no typical woman of first-century Israel would take the initiative to speak to a man, much less invite him to "her" home. Since Martha and Mary lived with their brother, he would be the obvious head of the household, even if he were much younger than his sisters. Astonishingly, Lazarus is not home to host or chaperone this event. Mary may have chosen "the better part," but Martha's role was equally bold and unconventional.

#### **Questions for Reflection and Sharing:**

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Commentary resonates with me?



**Pro-Life Corner:** The road to Auschwitz was built by hate, but paved with indifference. Today the horrors of Nazi Germany may be past, but in America today an ever greater number

of human beings are on the road to their own deaths in a state subsidized killing center, an abortion clinic. The Holocaust murdered twelve million people. Since 1973, over 61,500,000 unborn babies in America alone have been murdered by the holocaust of surgical abortion.

#### **Here are some steps to help you prepare for a Holy Hour:**

**1. Prep-work:** We need to remember that we need to prepare for the event. If we are on our way to church to pray, do we have the music going with the latest hit or are we beginning to focus on Jesus Christ? We need to "pray before we pray." It sounds funny but praying that God would bless our prayer and dispose us by removing distractions and anxieties is key.

**2. Enter In:** When we get to the place where we have gone to pray, it is time to focus. At this time, it is helpful to offer the time with our Lord for an intention, whether it is for our family, friends, the Church, or a distress of our times.

**3. Practice Prayer:** We need to practice things to become good at them. If there is difficulty in a type of prayer you are practicing, to the point where you cannot focus, then move on to another type of prayer.

**4. Thank God:** Collect mentally all of the graces and experiences we have received and thank God for them. Then we can end the time with an Our Father or Hail Mary.

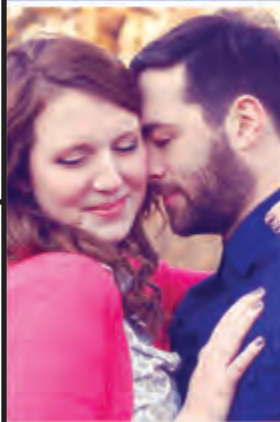
